The young men who grew up with him spoke to him, saying, “Thus you shall say to this people who spoke to you, saying, ‘Your father made our yoke heavy, now you make it lighter for us!’ But you shall speak to them, ‘

1 Kings 12:11

'Whereas my father loaded you with a heavy yoke, I will add to your yoke; my father disciplined you with whips, but I will discipline you with scorpions.' ”

1. Wise counsel is **sought out**.
(it's your responsibility to get it)



Proverbs 4:6-7

*Do not forsake wisdom, and she will protect you; love her, and she will watch over you. Wisdom is supreme; therefore **get wisdom.** Though it cost all you have, **get understanding.***

2. Wise counsel **doesn't** just tell
you **what you want** to hear.



*Many do not want to hear the truth,
they just want someone to tell them
that what they believe is truth.*



3. Wise counsel will align with
God's best for you.



Romans 8:29

*For those whom He foreknew, He
also predestined **to become
conformed to the image of His
Son**, so that He would be the
firstborn among many brethren;*

*What is best for you is what will
make you most like Jesus!*
